Complete the study guide

Complete any make-up work

Study a minimum of 15 minutes each day for 3 days

Participate in class more - be more engaged

Complete missing homework assignments

Make better use of class time

Ask questions on topics I do not understand

Take detailed notes in class

Pay more attention in class - focus more

Stipulations with the Retake Procedure

Delsea Middle School will allow retakes as a way to demonstrate increased learning.

Qualifying grades - any student who receives a score of 74 or lower may retest.

A retake may only be granted if a legitimate attempt at the original assessment was made first. Students will receive *one* retest opportunity per assignment.

Retakes are not permitted on homework, classwork, Accelerated Reader quizzes or the marking period assessment.

Students will receive an average of the original grade and the retake grade as long as a student's grade on the assessment improves.

The retake could include a portion of the original assessment or a different assessment (different format, different questions etc.).

The retest should be completed within two weeks of the student receiving the original test score.

Students must complete the list of teacher required assignments in order to receive a retest. Credit will not be given for the make up assignments.

It is the student's responsibility to approach the teacher for a retest. Teachers will remind students the option is available.
